CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kenneth L. Haskew, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Spring through a developed spring, diversion box, pipeline and stockwatering trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T.10S., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 35 bears S. 36° 20' E., a distance of 1,315.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Colvin Cattle Co., Inc.  
Post-office address Goldfield, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0022 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation April 2, 1984

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is diverted from a developed spring, equipped with a diversion box with 60' of 4" perforated PVC pipeline at spring, thence the water is conveyed by 1240' of 1" PVC pipeline to a 4' x 4' trough where 500 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 35, T.10S., R.43E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
