CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Big Antelope Springs through a developed spring, pipeline and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, T.22N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of Section 30, T.22N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 83° 09' 03" W., a distance of 5,616.66 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.012 c f ., or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 16, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a developed spring, thence the water is conveyed 325' by 1-1/2" pipeline to a circular trough 45' in diameter where 600 head of cattle water within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29, T.22N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
