CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (White Sage Canyon Well)

through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering trough for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 14, T.21N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 13, T.21N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 52° 07' 00" E., a distance of 7,790.00 feet

situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Paul Inchauspe

Post-office address Austin, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 16, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from a drilled well, equipped with a pump jack and gas motor, thence the water is conveyed to a concrete trough 30' x 20' x 2' deep where 400 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, T.21N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
