CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kenneth L. Haskew, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Goldbar Spring (Mud Spring, Gold Spring)

through a developed spring, pipeline and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T.11S., R.46E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 8 bears S. 68° 36' W., a distance of 1,408.0 feet

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Colvin Cattle Co., Inc., c/o Ben Colvin

Post-office address Goldfield, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0022 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 3, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from a developed spring, thence the water is conveyed 140' by 1" pipeline to two troughs, one 15' x 3-1/2' x 20" deep and one 10-1/2' x 2-1/2' x 16" deep where 200 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, T.11S., R.46E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
