CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Winecup Well AKA Bell Canyon Well) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering trough for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 3, T.43N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 2, T.43N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 73° 05' E., a distance of 9,782.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lands of Sierra, Inc.
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.009 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 19, 1985

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 4-1/2 hp diesel motor and jack pump, thence the water is conveyed 15' by 1-1/2" pipeline to a concrete stock trough 20' in diameter, 2' deep where 600 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 3, T.43N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
