CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring through a developed spring, pipeline and stockwatering trough for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 25, T.44N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 25 bears N. 45° 50' W., a distance of 2,160.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ronald M. Florance
Post-office address: Palos Verdes Peninsula, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.009 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a developed spring consisting of excavation and installation of perforated culvert, thence the water is conveyed 800' by PVC pipeline to a trough where 300 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 25, T.44N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
