CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Steve Cunningham, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from The Truckee River via Lake Ditch

through a pump and pipeline for As Decreed

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 19 bears S. 88° 05' E., a distance of 262.0 feet

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

2.185 acres in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 7, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changed the place of use of a portion of Claim #221 Truckee River Final Decree, in Equity, Docket A-3, in the District Court of the United States, in and for the District of Nevada.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and thus limited to 2.0 acre-feet for 0.615 acres of land as decreed.

The total combined duty under this certificate and any certificates issued under Permits 48266 and 48267 shall not exceed 7.51 acre-feet as decreed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
