CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source

through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, T.35N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 36 bears S. 56° 47' 49" E., a distance of 1,321.15 feet

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.042 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.86 million gallons annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation December 30, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 280 feet deep, 8 inch casing at

2.5 feet to 240 feet, equipped with a 1-1/2 horsepower submersible pump. The

water is used for commercial purposes within a portion of the S 1/2 SE 1/4 of Section

36, T.35N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
