CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Virgil L. Whitten, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Seasonal Stream (Spike Stockwater Pit) through a pit reservoir for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15, T.42N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 15 bears S. 38° 37' E., a distance of 1,064.1 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:  
Name of appropriator: U.S.D.I. Bureau of Land Management (50% interest); Sand Creek Grazing Association (50% interest)  
Post-office address: Susanville, Lake City, CA, respectively  
Amount of appropriation: 0.0041 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 130 head of cattle  
Period of use, from April 16th to July 30th of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: May 8, 1986

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is diverted from an unnamed seasonal stream to a 90' x 90' x 9' stockwatering pit from which 130 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 15, T.42N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
