CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jim Nelson, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Wallace Canyon Spring through a collection basin Wildlife and Recreation for purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the GLO brass cap common to Tracts 43, 53 and 54, in the SW 1/4 Section 15, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 84 degrees E., a distance of 4,780.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States of America-Forest Service
Post-office address: Sparks, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.015 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.405 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 5, 1987

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a spring to a collection basin 4' x 2' in dimension where 100 deer, 10 elk and non-game animals and 50 hikers per annum water within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 16, T.19S., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
