CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Rodney Harris, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Intercepted Precipitation (Catchement Basin) through a catchement apron and storage pit for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 13, T.27N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., at a point from which the NE corner of Section 1, T.27N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 12° 0' E., a distance of 13,380.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management and Lear Ranches
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle, 50 wild horses, and 200 deer
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 6, 1986

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from intercepted precipitation by a 150' x 150' sheet metal catchement apron to a 90,000 gallon storage pit and a 1500 gallon trough from which 100 head of cattle, 50 wild horses and 200 deer water within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, T.27N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
