CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Leo K. Stewart, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Badger Spring

through a developed spring, pipeline and trench for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T.7S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 6, T.7S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 77° 46' 00" E., a distance of 49,211.92 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Leo K. Stewart
Post-office address: Alamo, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.003 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 3, 1988

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from a developed spring, thence the water is conveyed via a trench 3'-7' deep for approximately 130'. Water is piped 100' to a 500 gallon storage tank where 100 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 10 and the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 15, T.7S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
