CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank Shields, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Denio Summit Well) through a drilled well, windmill and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T.46N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 13 bears N. 22° 55' E., a distance of 2,900.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 350 head of cattle and 6 deer
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a drilled well, 300 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a windmill and 300' of 2-1/2" pipe, thence the water is conveyed to two 450 gallon troughs and one 10' diameter earthen catchment basin of approximately 2300 gallons and 4 storage tanks where 350 head of cattle and 6 deer water within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 13, T.46N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
