CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank Shields, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Desert Queen Well) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22, T.21N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 22 bears S. 82° 06' 50" W., a distance of 2,493.99 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bureau of Land Management (50% interest); Ceresola Bros. (50% interest)
Post-office address: Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.004 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 110 head of cattle and 17 wild horses
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 6" diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed to a 30 foot in diameter 2' deep trough where 110 head of cattle and 17 wild horses water within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 22, T.21N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
