CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank C. Shields, Agent has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Depoli Well)

through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 14, T.21N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14 bears N. 41° 25' 03" E., a distance of 1,504.79 feet

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bureau of Land Management (50% interest); Ceresola Bros. (50% interest)

Post-office address Winnemucca, Wadsworth, Nevada, respectively

Amount of appropriation 0.004 s., or sufficient to water 110 head of cattle and 17 wild horses

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a pump, thence the water is conveyed to a 5,000 gallon trough where 110 head of cattle and 17 wild horses water within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 14, T.21N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
