CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Virgil L. Whitten, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Seasonal Stream (Alley Stockwatering Pit) through a lead-in ditch and pit reservoir for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 8 (within SW 1/4) Section 31 T.41N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 31 bears N. 11° 22' 21" W., a distance of 1,819.28 feet

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator U.S.D.I. Bureau of Land Management (1/2 interest) and Cockrell, Inc. (1/2 interest)

Post-office address Susanville, CA and Cedarville, CA, respectively

Amount of appropriation 0.0041 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 30 head of cattle

Period of use, from April 1st to October 15th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 24, 1985

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an unnamed seasonal stream by a 50' lead-in ditch, 2' deep x 14' wide, thence the water is conveyed to a pit reservoir 108' x 116' x 12' deep where 130 head of cattle water within Lot 8 of Section 31, T.41N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
