CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (West Bench Well) through a drilled well, pump jack and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 34, T.40N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 34 bears S. 83° 12' E., a distance of 3,975.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lands of Sierra, Inc.
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.018 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 700 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 6, 1985

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a drilled well, 405 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a diesel driven pump jack, thence the water is conveyed to a stockwatering tank 2' deep x 30' in diameter and overflow ponds where 600 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 and SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 34, T.40N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
