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THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Brown Dike Well) through a drilled well, windmill and stockwatering trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.26N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 9, T.26N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 83° 12' 00" W., a distance of 9,340.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.006 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation February 25, 1985

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
 Water is developed from a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a windmill and pump jack, thence the water is conveyed by 10 feet of 2-1/2" pipe to a stockwatering tank 3' deep x 16' in diameter where 200 head of cattle water within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T.26N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
