CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, S. K. Howard, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mud Gulch Spring #1 through a buried spring box, pipeline and stockwatering trough for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T.45N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 25, T.45N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 75° 45' W., a distance of 14,490.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Howard Ranches
Post-office address: Bruneau, Idaho
Amount of appropriation: 0.009 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from: June 15th to November 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 29, 1981

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a buried intake box, thence the water is conveyed by 40' of pipeline to a 300 gallon trough where 300 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28, T.45N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
