CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Demar H. Dahl, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Section 9 well) through a drilled well, pump jack and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T.34N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 9, bears S. 39° 31' W., a distance of 5051 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Flying "S" Land and Cattle Company
Post-office address: Deeth, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0178 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 100 horses
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 7, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 140.0 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a Jensen pump jack and a Briggs and Stratton meter, thence the water is conveyed by a 3 inch pipe, 6 feet to a 3 foot by 4 foot by 21 foot stock trough where 1,000 head of cattle and 100 horses water within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9, T.34N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
