CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ernest Paine, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Baldwin Canyon Well) through a drilled well, pump, and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T.7N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S 1/2 corner of said Section 23 bears S. 59° 28' 0" E., a distance of 801.51 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Flying M Ranch an undivided co-holder with U.S.D.I. Bureau of Land Management
Post-office address: Yerington, Nevada and Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.03 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 18, 1986

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from a drilled well of unknown depth, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed to a 5,000 gallon storage tank and four (4) 450 gallon troughs where 1,000 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T.7N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
