CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B.J. Vasey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring #2

through a collection box, pipelines and storage tank for Domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 32, T.45N., R.56 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 32, bears S 57° 50' W., a distance of 2,840.08 feet.

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator. Donald & Barbara Wellington

Post-office address. Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation. 0.0022 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.519 million gallons annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation. April 19, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a collection box located at the source thence conveyed via 3/4 inch copper pipeline to a 500 gallon storage tank. Distribution for domestic purposes is by means of a 12 volt 2 1/2 gallon per minute electric pump. Water is used for a single household and the immediate landscaping needs. The place of use is the W 1/2 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32, T.45N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
