CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, U.S. Department of the Interior - Bureau of Land Management has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Odger's Well) through a drilled well, pump, and stockwatering trough for Stockwater and Wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 7, T.29N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 7 bears N. 73° 01' W., a distance of 450.2 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.006 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle and 10 antelope
Period of use, from May 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 11, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a pump, 5,000 gallon storage tank, thence the water is conveyed by 100' of pipe to a 1,500 gallon trough where 250 head of cattle and 10 antelope water within Lot 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 7, T.29N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
