CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George H. Denson, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 17, T.13N., R.26E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 17, bears S. 5° 29' 58" W., a distance of 1,827.24 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Frade Ranches, Inc.
Post-office address: Yerington, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0047 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 6, 1987

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 183 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 25 horsepower U.S. Motors Holloshaft pump, thence the water is conveyed by 80 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to a 12 foot diameter stock tank where 150 head of cattle water within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 17, T.13N., R.26E., M.D.B.&M.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
