CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J.S. Tixier, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cherry Spring through a headbox, pipe, tank and trough for Stockwater and Wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T.25N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 35, T.26N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 29° 35' W., a distance of 11,600 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States of America - Forest Service
Post-office address: Ogden, Utah
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s or sufficient to water 1,250 sheep, 40 horses and 360 deer
Period of use, from: May 16th to October 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 26, 1981

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from Cherry Spring by a sealed headbox from which it is conveyed by a 1 1/2" pipe to a 2,000 gallon storage tank and a stockwatering trough where 1,250 sheep, 40 horses and 360 deer water within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T.25N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
