

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George G. Assuras, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hunter Creek through an open ditch, piping and distribution system for Municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. from which point the SE corner of said Section 10 bears S. 69° 57' 58" E., a distance of 842.34 feet (Idlewild Pump Station - Treatment Plant) situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Sierra Pacific Power Company
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 13.6 c.f.s but not to exceed 3208.76 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: as decreed to: of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: \*as decreed

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water will be diverted from Hunter Creek by means of an open ditch and the Truckee River and transported to any or all existing treatment plants. The water is then pumped to the Sierra Pacific Power Company's water customers within its certified water service area. Said service area is depicted by record (map and legal description) which is filed with the State Engineer's Office.

\*This Certificate changes the point of diversion of Claim 726 of the Truckee River Decree, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 726.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The total combined diversion rate and duty of this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 44591, and the diversion points delineated under Claim 726 of the Truckee River Decree, shall not exceed 13.6 c.f.s. nor 3208.76 million gallons annually.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
