CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Nancy Phelts Dailey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Horse Canyon Well) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater and Wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T.36N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 20, T.36N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 77° 45' 22" W., a distance of 11,106.11 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States Bureau of Land Management
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0085 c.f.s or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle and 100 deer
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 29, 1981

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 490 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump powered by a portable generator, thence the water is conveyed to a stock trough where 250 head of cattle and 100 deer water within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T.36N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M.
This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
