CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard D. Moser, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River

through a canal, treatment plant and distribution system for Municipal and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. from which point the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 62° 04' 00" E., a distance of 3,195.0 feet (Steamboat Canal - Hunter Creek Reservoir) situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

- Name of appropriator: Sierra Pacific Power Company
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.5075 c.f.s but not to exceed 112.79 acre-feet as decreed
Period of use, from: as decreed to: of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *as decreed

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use: Said water is diverted from the Truckee River and transported in the Steamboat Canal until it is diverted at the Hunter Creek diversion, where it is diverted to the treatment plant. After the water is treated at Hunter Creek Treatment Plant, it is then pumped into Sierra Pacific Power Company's distribution system consisting of various size piping, water storage tanks and booster pumps. The overall system ultimately conveys the treated water to Sierra Pacific Power Company's water customers within its certified water service area, said service area is depicted by record (legal description and map) which is filed with the State Engineer's office.

*This Certificate changes the manner of use and place of use of a portion of Claim 74 of the Truckee River Final Decree, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 74.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
