CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from November 1st to February 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: March 31, 1986

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from surface runoff by a dug and embanked pond 75' x 200' where 500 head of cattle water within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 28, T.6N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
