CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T.38N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 34 bears N. 53° 45' W., a distance of 112.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.24 c.f.s but not to exceed 54.75 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 3, 1974

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by a 400 foot deep well by a submersible pump thence through 6,245 feet of 2 inch diameter pipe to 18 stockwatering troughs for commercial purposes within the W 1/2 E 1/2, Section 34, T.38N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
