CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from State Line Springs through the natural channel and an earth dam for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, T.42N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 16, T.42N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 07° 54' E., a distance of 9,598.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lands of Sierra, Inc.
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.013 c.f.s, or sufficient to water 1,100 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to: December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 5, 1987

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from State Line Springs by the natural channel and an earth dam impounding water at the point of diversion where 1,100 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, T.42N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
