CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Elton Parsons, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and tanker truck for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 20, T.2N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 24, T.2N., R.37E., bears N. 79° 46' 17" W., a distance of 8,431.56 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Coaldale via Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.223 c.f.s but not to exceed 1.3084 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 6, 1985

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 220 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via a 15 H.P. submersible pump, thence conveyed by truck to a tanker for potable use at a restaurant, bar, service station and motel located within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and W 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, T.2N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M. for quasi-municipal purposes.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
