CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Katherine A. Rice, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring through a spring, collection box and distribution system for Commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, T.10N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 2 bears S. 51° 29' 13" W., a distance of 1,554.0 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Wellington, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.25 c.f.s but not to exceed 10.2 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 1, 1980

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a spring through a pipeline to a water treatment and distribution system, thence conveyed to 2 homes, 13 mobile homes, 18 recreation vehicle hookups, and 5 acres of landscaping located in portions of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and the SW 1/4 of Section 2, T.10N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
