CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an Underground Source (Idavada Well)

through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 8 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 2, T.47N.,

R.64E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 2 bears

N. 60° 40' 42" E., a distance of 1,689.02 feet

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Y-3 II

Post-office address Boise, Idaho

Amount of appropriation 0.009 c.f.s or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 1, 1988

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a drilled well 569 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing to 129' and 6 inch diameter casing to total depth, equipped with a submersible electric pump powered by a portable generator, thence the water is conveyed via pipeline to a 5,000 gallon storage tank then to two stockwatering troughs where 300 head of cattle water within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T.47N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
