CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Virgil Stephens, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lee Hot Springs through a drain ditch, pipe and stockwater troughs for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T.16N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 33 bears S. 53° 32' 32" W., a distance of 6,338.51 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Rolling A. Ranch
Post-office address: Dayton, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0045 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use, from: November 1st to March 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 7, 1981

Description of: the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by a 200' drainage ditch to a 12' x 12' pond then 400 feet underground by 2" plastic pipe to a 400 gallon trough overflowing into an existing pond where 200 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, T.16N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M.

This Certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
