CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Richard L. Hafen, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and sprinkler system for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 8 bears N. 62° 22' 36" W., a distance of 790.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s but not to exceed 40.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation \*June 22, 1955

Description of: land to which the water is appurtenant:

8.0 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 34681 which changed the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 16570, Certificate 5504, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 16570, Certificate 5504.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
