CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, James L. Hogan, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Culinary and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW1/4 SE1/4 Section 11, T.5N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 11 bears N. 24° 40' E., a distance of 4,000 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Reverend Leo Slatterie

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Culinary and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.03 c.f.s. but not to exceed 2.92 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: July 9, 1981

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 70 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via a Sears multistage 210 pump with a Wisconsin motor and Winco 2,00 watt generator, thence through plastic pipe to 8 housing units for culinary and domestic purposes located within the NW1/4 SE1/4 and SW1/4 SE1/4 Section 11, T.5N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
