**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from South Dinner Spring through an improved spring and natural channel for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE1/4 SW1/4 Section 8, T.43N., R.70E.,  
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW  
corner of said Section 8 bears S. 48° 40' W.,  
a distance of 2,366.0 feet situated in Elko  
County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lands of Sierra, Inc.  
Source: South Dinner Spring  
Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic  
Amount of appropriation: 0.0343 c.f.s. or sufficient to water  
1,100 head of cattle  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each  
year  
Date of priority of  
appropriation: November 5, 1987


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from an improved spring and natural channel from which 1,100 head of cattle water within the NE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 8, T.43N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and further subject to the State Engineer's Ruling No. 3674 dated January 23, 1990.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
