CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Wine Cup Well No. 9) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW1/4 NW1/4 Section 27, T.41N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N1/4 corner of said Section 27 bears N. 64' 20' E., a distance of 1,680.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lands of Sierra, Inc.
Source: Underground (Wine Cup Well No. 9)
Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.027 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 5, 1987

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a drilled well, 50 feet deep, 5 inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump, thence the water is conveyed via 2" pipeline to an 80 gallon storage tank thence to a stockwatering tank 30' in diameter by 18" high where 1,000 head of cattle water within the NW1/4 NW1/4 Section 27, T.41N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
