CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bull Spring through a natural channel and small earthen dam for Stockwater and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 25, T.44N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 36, T.44N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 36° 18' E., a distance of 7,830.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lands of Sierra, Inc.

Source: Bull Spring

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.0312 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: November 5, 1987

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is retained by a small earthen dam within the natural channel where 1,000 head of cattle water within the SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 25, T.44N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and further subject to the State Engineer's Ruling No. 3673 dated January 23, 1990.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
