CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Virgil L. Whitten, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Seasonal Stream through a pit reservoir for Stockwater and Wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 5 of Section 36, T.40n., R.18E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the W1/4 corner of said Section 36 bears N. 44° 59' 24" W., a distance of 2,464.60 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S.D.I. Bureau of Land Management (1/2 interest), Home Camp Land and Livestock Company (1/2 interest)

Source: an Unnamed Seasonal Stream

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Wildlife

Amount of appropriation: 0.00166 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle

Period of use: July 1st to September 15th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 25, 1989


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an unnamed seasonal stream into a pit reservoir 80' x 80' x 8' where 50 head of cattle water within Lot 5, T.40n., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
