CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John Perkowski, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Industrial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE1/4 SW1/4 Section 16, T.12N., R.20E.,
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW
corner of said Section 16 bears S. 84° 42' 0"
W., a distance of 2,618.0 feet situated in
Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of Use: Industrial and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.03 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.803
million gallons annually

Period of use: Janaury 1st to December 31st of each
year

Date of priority of
appropriation: August 14, 1985

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 130 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via a submersible pump, thence conveyed to a 2,000 square foot building and a 13,380 square foot building for industrial and domestic purposes located within the SE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 16, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
