CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Joseph Borgerding, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Hot Springs through a series of ponds and channels for Recreation and Wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW1/4 NW1/4 Section 21, T.14N., R.20E.,
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW
corner of said Section 21 bears S. 0° 35' W.,
a distance of 4,020.0 feet situated in Douglas
County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Incline Village General Improvement District
Source: an Unnamed Hot Springs
Manner of Use: Recreation and Wildlife
Amount of appropriation: *1.45 c.f.s.
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 10, 1986


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is allowed to flow through a series of ponds and channels in the same direction it has historically flowed. These ponds and channels serve as a habitat for water birds and fish within portions of Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate is issued for non-consumptive recreational and wildlife habitat use.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
