CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Forman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Moorman Spring through a spring box, pipeline and storage tank for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW1/4 SE1/4, Section 16, T.17N., R.59E.,
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE
corner of Section 10, T.17N., R.59E.,
M.D.B.&M. bears N. 58° 39' 43" E., a distance
of 9,003.96 feet situated in White Pine
County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Robert E. Dickenson
Source: Moorman Spring
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation: 0.0022 c.f.s. but not to exceed
0.519 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each
year
Date of priority of
appropriation: July 24, 1986

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted by means of a spring box, via 9,300 feet of plastic pipe to a 10,000 gallon storage tank, thence through a distribution system to three residences, yards and gardens for quasi-municipal purposes located in the SE1/4 NE1/4, Section 9 and the NW1/4 of Section 10, all in T.17N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M.

The total duty of water under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 51857 shall not exceed 1.97 million gallons annually.

This certificate is issue subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
