CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, John E. Curran, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Industrial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW1/4 SE1/4 Section 3, T.20N., R.24E.,
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S1/4
corner of said Section 3 bears S. 9' 15' W., a
distance of 2,476.0 feet situated in Washoe
County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Lee Smith aka Lee S. Smith
Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Industrial and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.05 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1.221 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*March 14, 1978

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 170 feet deep, 6 5/8" diameter casing equipped with a 2 H.P. submersible pump, then through 550 feet of 2" diameter pipe, 200 feet of 1 1/2" diameter pipe, 200 feet of 1 1/4" diameter pipe and 300 feet of 1" diameter pipe where it is used for industrial and domestic purposes within 14.87 acres located north of old U.S. Highway 40 in the NW1/4 SE1/4 Section 3, T.20N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

The combined duty for this certificate, Certificates 11904 and 11906 and any certificates granted under Permits 53820 and 54195 shall not exceed 3.714 million gallons annually.

*This certificate changes the manner of use of Permit 46535, which changed the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 38484, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 35117, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 35117.

The combined diversion rate of this certificate and Certificate 11906 is limited to 0.073 c.f.s.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
