CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Katherine A. Rice, as agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Silver Bow Fork Spring through an improved spring for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW1/4 NW1/4 Section 13, T.1N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 4 T.1N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M. bears N 60° 33' E., a distance of 22,925 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe B. Fallini, Helen L. Fallini and Susan L. Fallini
Source: Silver Bow Fork Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.032 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 25 horses
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 22, 1988


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a small cutout in the side of a hill at Silver Bow Fork Spring, a cleaned spring and drainage area where 1,000 head of cattle and 25 horses water within the NW1/4 NW1/4 Section 13, T.1N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
