CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Wallace T. Boundy, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring through a spring box, pump or pipeline for Mining and Milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE1/4 SE1/4, Section 26, T.9N., R.45E.,
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E1/4
corner of said Section 26 bears N. 81° 34' 02"
E., a distance of 1,121.02 feet situated in
Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Robert J. Frank**
Source: **an Unnamed Spring**
Manner of Use: **Mining and Milling**
Amount of appropriation: **0.015 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1.1 million gallons annually**
Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st of each year**
Date of priority of appropriation: **June 27, 1988**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by means of a spring box, via pump or pipeline to a portable screening plant for mining and milling purposed located within the NE1/4 SE1/4, Section 26, T.9N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
