**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Jim McDowell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE1/4 NW1/4, Section 35, T.42N., R.52E.,  
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the W1/4  
corner of said Section 35 bears S. 82° 29' 32"  
W., a distance of 1,952.28 feet situated in  
Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Jack Creek Water Users Association  
Source: Underground  
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal  
Amount of appropriation: 0.074 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.637 million gallons annually  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: August 20, 1982


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 170 feet deep, 6 inch casing, via a submersible pump and motor, thence through a distribution system to 40 lots in a 10 acre subdivision located in portions of the SE1/4 NW1/4, N1/2 SW1/4, SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 35, T.42N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
