CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J.R. Fenn, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Mining purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE1/4 SE1/4, Section 29, T.23N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 29 bears S. 44° 22' 12" E., a distance of 1,440.65 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Mining
Amount of appropriation:	0.0463 c.f.s. but not to exceed 2.543 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	April 30, 1986

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 581 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via a 15 H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to a portion of the S1/2, SE1/4 NE1/4, Section 29; Section 28, 32 and N1/2 NW1/4, NW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 33, all in T.23N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M. for mining purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
