**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

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WHEREAS, Alan F. Walter, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Well No. 23A) (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 21, T.20S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.  
or at a point from which the NE corner of said  
Section 21 bears N. 80° 22' 07" E., a distance  
of 576.12 feet situated in Clark County, State  
of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Las Vegas Valley Water District
Source:	Underground (Well No. 23A) (Las Vegas Artesian Basin)
Manner of Use:	Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.299 c.f.s. but not to exceed 24.44 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*September 20, 1950

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 925 feet deep, 20 inch casing, via a deep well pump to pipelines and reservoirs, thence through a distribution system to the area included within the boundaries of the Las Vegas Valley Water District as denoted by Chapter 167, Statutes of Nevada, 1947, as it now exists or as it may hereafter be amended for municipal and domestic purposes.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 27963, Certificate 8835, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 13497, Certificate 4137, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 13497, Certificate 4137.


The total combined rate of diversion and the total duty of water granted under Permit 28987, Certificate 10039, Permit 28988, Certificate 10040, Permit 28989, Certificate 10041, Permit 46993, Certificate 11818, and any certificates issued under Permits 51103, 52788, 52791, 52792, 52793 and 52794 shall not exceed 5.1266 c.f.s. and 705.182 million gallons annually, respectively.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
